WHITE WINE

150ml

2015 Pewsey Vale 'Contours' Riesling *Eden Valley SA* 23

Australian dry riesling is the best value white wine in the world today. It suits any budget, it tastes great young and can age 20+ years. It's amazing with food, it speaks of its origins and has this intoxicating mix of flavour and freshness that suits dining tables, sun lounges and picnic blankets. This iconic Pewsey Vale Riesling is named after its vineyard which follows the contours of its hilly setting high in the Eden Valley. This is Riesling with complexity, power, and purity.

2019 Domaine Vacheron *Sancerre FR* 31

The origin story for Sauvignon Blanc begins in France and the limestone filled vineyards of Sancerre in the Loire Valley. It's hard to believe that the fruity and herbaceous wines from New Zealand that have dominated the white wine category for the last 20 years are from the same family tree! This is savvy with minerality and elegance, and layered with that mouth watering sensation that quenches your thirst and makes you thirsty all at the same time.

2014 Isole E Olena 'Collectizone Privata' Chard. *Toscana IT* 38

A stunningly powerful Chardonnay from renown Tuscan producer Isole E Olena. This wine is rich and concentrated with notes of ripe fruit and citrus alongside butter, almonds and a touch of oak. With this vintage now reaching the 8 year mark, it is drinking beautifully.

2019 Domaine Laroche 'Montee de Tonnerre' *Chablis 1er Cru FR* 49

Perched on a the east bank of the Serin River just outside of the township of Chablis is the regions most famous vineyards, Montee de Tonnerre. This is a stunning release for Laroche and a wine full of contrast. Full of saline, mineral driven elegance framing rich and energetic fruit flavours. It is both powerful and refined, and a near perfect example of why drinking Chablis is one of the most addictive wine experiences on earth.

RED WINE

2019 Oakridge '864 Henk Vineyard' Pinot Noir *Yarra Valley VIC* 48

Pinot Noir is sensitive to literally everything in a vineyard. Light, heat, water, and of course soil all need to be just right. You then need the right person to coax the grapes from the vine into the bottle without upsetting the delicate balance of aroma, flavour and texture. No one in Australia is better at this vinous high wire act than Dave Bicknell of Oakridge wines. This wine is one of the best releases of 2019 and is drinking beautifully.

2005 Clarendon Estate 'Onkaparinga' Grenache *McLaren Vale SA* 39

Traditionally Australian grenache didn't age well. They were too juicy when young, too alcoholic and lacked the tannin and acid wireframe for a long journey. But with its elegance and refinement balanced with layers of red and dark fruits infused with oak complexity and pitch perfect tannin this wine redraws the boundary lines as to what is possible with Australian Grenache. At peak drinking now and a stunning example of aged Australian red wine.

2012 Voyager Estate Cabernet Sauvignon *Margaret River WA* 42

No other grape has done more for Margaret River's reputation as a producer of world class wine than Cabernet Sauvignon. With its proximity to the ocean and its Mediterranean climate, Margaret River fashions Cabernet Sauvignon layered with deep, plush fruit flavours, sleek tannin and refreshing acidity. Voyager Estate is one of the region's best practitioners of Cabernet Sauvignon and at its 10th birthday this wine is in perfect gear with horsepower to spare.

2020 Jasper Hill 'Georgia & Friends' Shiraz *Heathcote VIC* 45

The crippling drought and bushfires of 2020 saw the volumes of grapes for many east coast wineries reduce by up to 80%. That means for every 10 grapes grown in 2019 only 2 were harvested in 2020. Jasper Hill reached out to their neighbours and friends and were able to secure enough fruit to release their iconic Georgia shiraz. This is Shiraz with the texture of Salmon roe when it pops on your tongue. Fresh and intensely flavoured but with a supple almost creamy texture it then races down your palette relaying its goodies of fruit and tannin finishing rich and satisfying. A beautiful wine from the toughest of circumstances.

2006 Bodegas Urbina 'Reserva Especial' *Rioja SPN* 35

Five generations of Urbinas have managed this property since the 1870s. Urbina make 'classically styled' Rioja from their own vines and are a village-specific producer, with their best wines all from the cold limestone sand soils of Cuzcurrita del Rio Tiron. 2006 was a warm year in Rioja and produced tempranillo with real depth and richness and long fine black tea tannins. At 16 years of age this wine is starting to mellow now with its dark and brooding fruit flavours and firm tannins softening becoming more complex and intriguing.

2016 Giovanni Manzone Castaletto *Barolo IT* 53

Nebbiolo is the swiss army knife of the wine world. It literally has a tool for every occasion. It drinks easy but can have the stamina to age 50 years. The taste and texture can feel like Pinot Noir on steroids and its savoury tannins literally melt when it comes into close contact with red proteins and good fats. Barolo in the north east of Italy is Nebbiolo's most prestigious address and 2016 is a vintage that many locals have declared the best this century.

2013 Mongeard-Mugneret *Vosne-Romanée FR* 69

Hailing from the small, but famous, burgundian village of Vosne-Romanée, the Mongeard family have been producing exquisite wines for more than eight generations. This wine is made with fruit harvested from the vineyards surrounding the village and showcases the greatness of the region that gave birth to pinot noir. Despite 2013 being a low yielding vintage due to a cold spring and summer downpours, the resulting crop ended up bearing great fruit and is drinking beautifully now after nearly 10 years.

SWEET WINE 90ml

2011 Cantalici Vin Santo *Tuscany IT* 29

Used to celebrate mass as far back as the the 14th century Vin Santo or Holy Wine is made by using a process known as passito where grapes are dried on straw mats to dehydrate them and concentrate both sugar and acidity. Age also plays a role with Vin Santo and over the centuries it has been revered for its ability to transform from light, bright and sweet to complex, deep and rich. Cantalici Vin Santo manages to bridge both worlds and blends the best of both youth and age in a heavenly version of this iconic Italian dessert wine.

Positioned at the entrance to the restaurant, Bar 133 acts as the hotel's social hub with a seasonal cocktail menu, an extensive wine selection and a home-made collection of syrups, fusions and shrubs, invigorating the Pascale offering.
